Calling all Kids for the Christmas Play

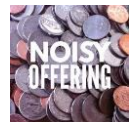
Sunday School is rounding up any kids that want to be part of the Christmas play this year. We will be practicing during Sunday School in December, and performing on December 22nd during service.

Hello Congregation,

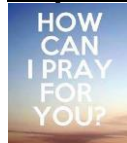

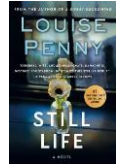
